If requesting non active membership, all forms must be uploaded; however, no insurance will be issued. Non active membership is \$175.

Outside of Canada:

 - **completion of a Prior Learning Assessment accepted by the College of Massage Therapists of PEI**
 - **and an exam from a Canadian provincially regulated body of massage therapy.**
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
